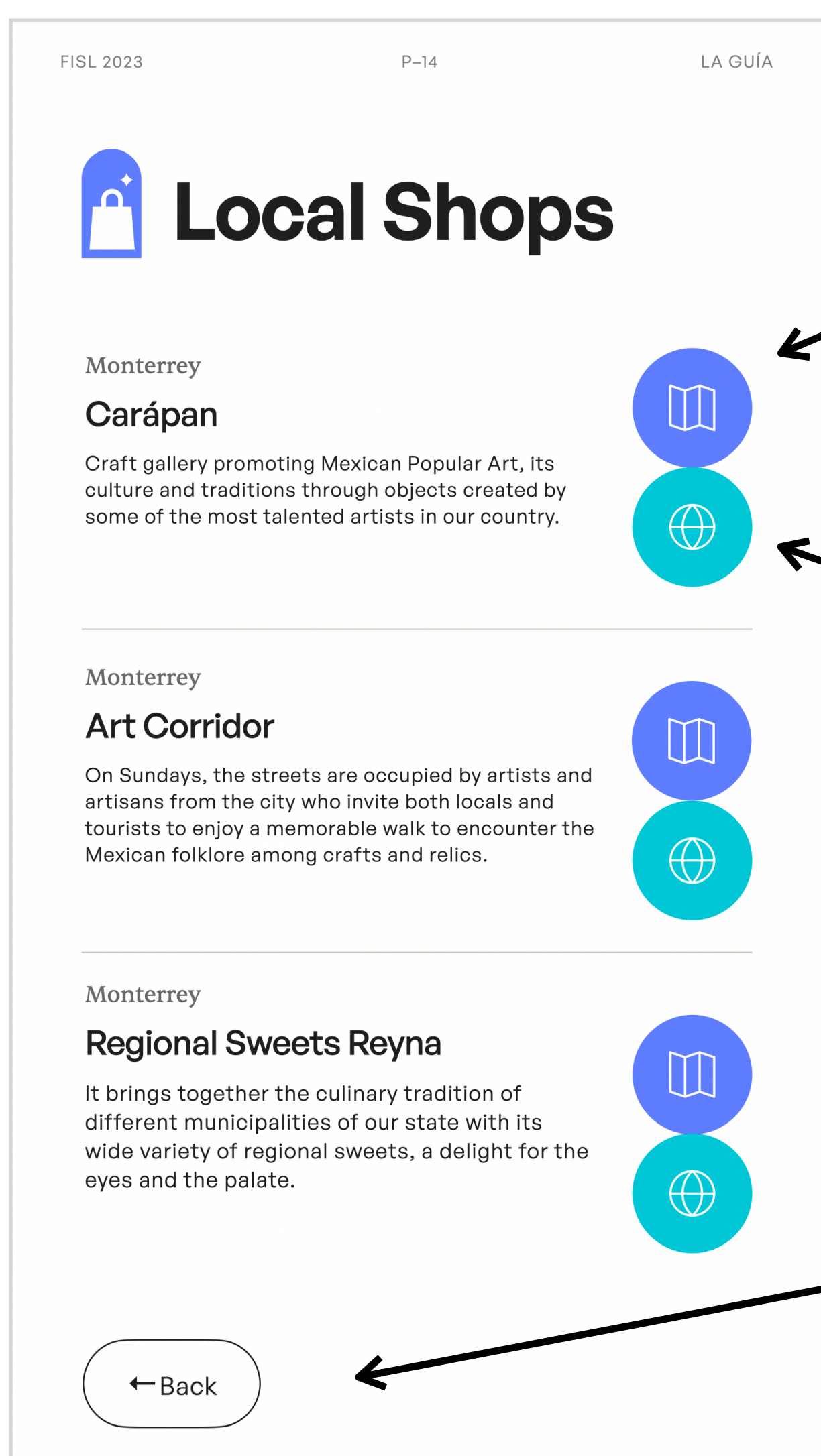
Indaga: an opening portal, a magical place of encounter for the local and the foreigner, the visitor and the host; a guide to enriching experiences.

Its great dome houses, among other things, a learning and exhibition space that encourages the creation and dissemination of the work of artists, creators and producers dedicated to generating research in the arts.



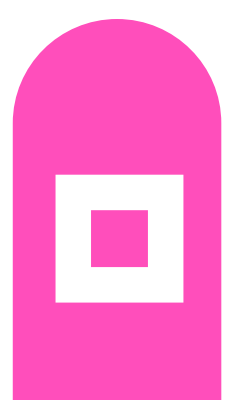

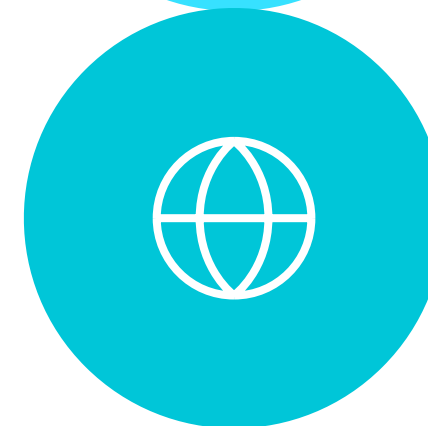
Former Federal Palace and Post Office, now a space purposely designed to promote creativity and innovation aimed at resolving conflicts and social problems.

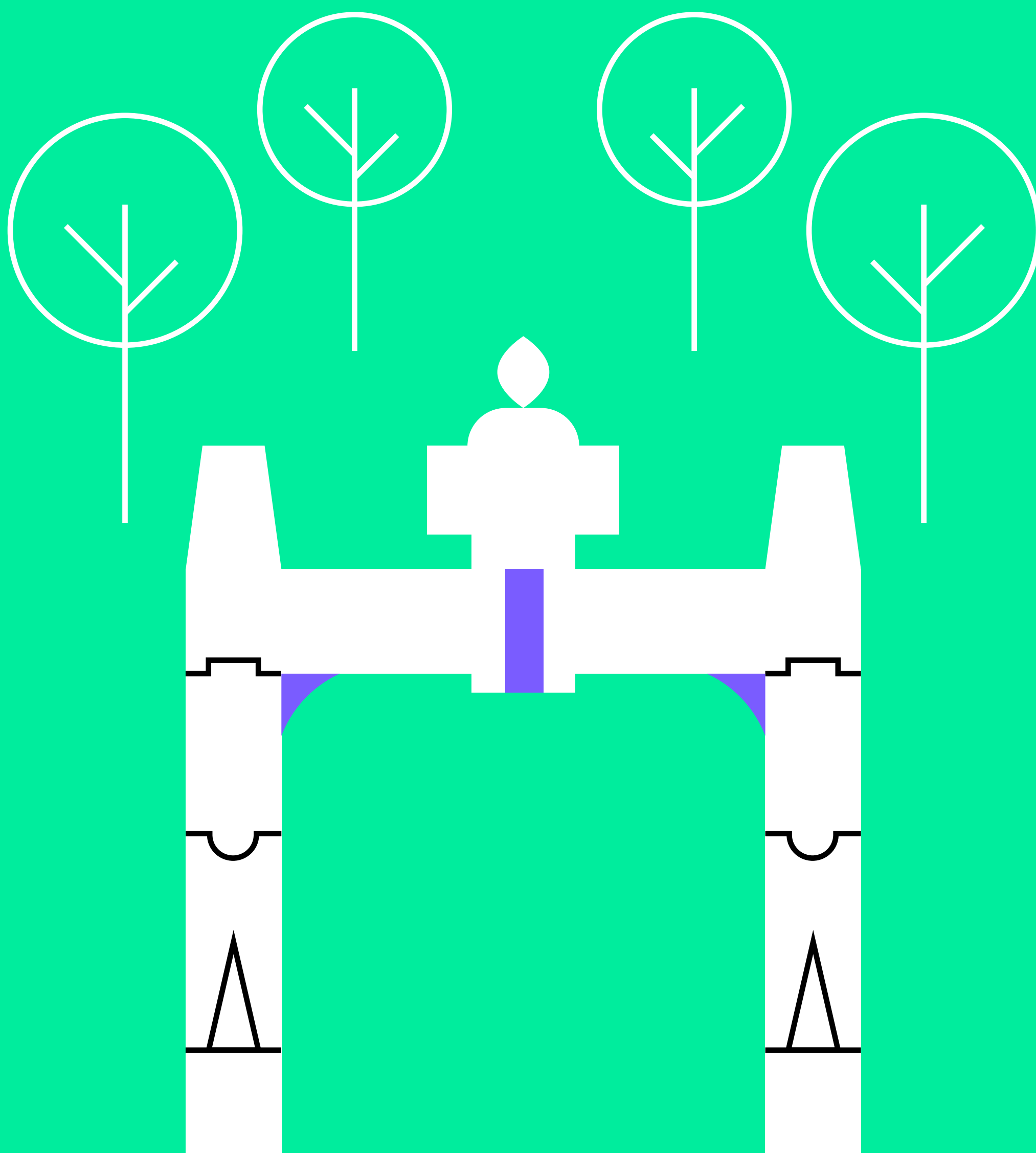
Templo de Nuestra Señora de los Dolores

We hope you treasure this Guide, so you may experience and relive it in the days, weeks, and years to come.

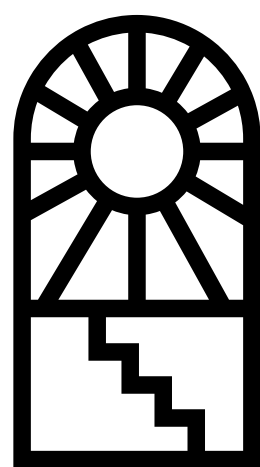
